Application Requirements

- A) Full curriculum vitae—please include country of citizenship
- B) A summary of past research, a research plan, and a teaching statement
- C) List of achievements (categorize into publications in refereed journals, presentations in international and domestic conferences, publications in conference proceedings, and so on)
- D) PDF files of (at most) three major papers
- E) (At least) one letter of professional recommendation—written within a year of the application—with the referee's name, title, affiliation, relationship and duration of the relationship with the applicant, and contact details included (note: we may conduct reference checks for candidates.)

Application documents can be either in English or in Japanese.

Combine the items A) -C) in Application Requirements together with the referee's name and e-mail address for item E) into one pdf file. Put a password on the file including the item A) and send the password in a separate mail. Send it with pdf files for item D) to the following via e-mail:
